



## Are you prepared for Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) new Condition of Participation (CoP) for hospitals?

The new CMS requirement for Electronic Admission, Discharge and Transfer (ADT) event notifications goes into effect May 1, 2021. The **CMS Interoperability and Patient Access final rule** requires Medicare and Medicaid participating Hospitals, Psychiatric Hospitals, and Critical Access Hospitals who utilize an Electronic Health Record (EHR) to make a reasonable effort to send real-time alerts to post-acute and primary care providers when a patient has been admitted, discharged or transferred from their facility.

**Idaho Health Data Exchange (IHDE)** is prepared to help you meet this requirement through the IHDE Clinical Portal. The Clinical Portal allows IHDE providers to receive a secure event notification when their patient is admitted, discharged, or transferred from your facility. When providers receive this notification, it will be in conjunction with access to the patients complete longitudinal medical record making it easier for the provider to review and plan next steps. The goal of the new CMS notification requirement is to improve transitions of care and coordination of services. By linking the ADT notification with seamless access to the patient's complete health record, IHDE is working to meet these goals and to help Idaho's citizens with more effective care management.
